PhD Session**

New deadline for submissions: Monday 19 October

Dear AEA-Europe Member – and incoming Member

At the AEA-Europe online Festival in November, one of the sessions will be dedicated to doctoral students within the AEA-Europe membership (although those who are thinking of becoming members are very welcome!). The aim of the session is to provide a unique and supportive environment that enables doctoral students to present their work and to receive constructive feedback on their research from the research community. The session will not only provide a very good opportunity to receive immediate and valuable feedback but also to meet other doctoral students and learn about their work.

During the session, each presenter will be given a maximum of 15 minutes. This will include time for a short presentation followed by a discussion. Since time is limited each presentation should focus on a limited part of the research and/or a specific problem such as the choice or use of theory or methodology, a question related to preliminary results, or a particular research challenge(s).

The session will take place in the afternoon, Thursday 5th November.

The presentation slots are limited, so if there are more presentations submitted than slots available, a selection will be made on the basis of diversity in topic and geographical representation.

In order to be considered for the event, we are asking doctoral students to submit a short abstract (no more than 300 words). Please also include your name, affiliation, and title of presentation.
